



TEN REASONS TO RE-ELECT THE BMCC/PSC NEW CAUCUS SLATE

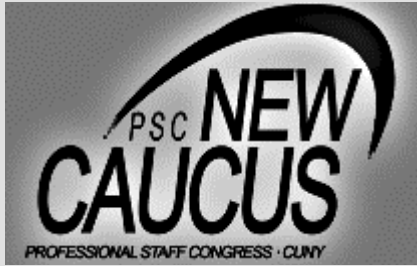
- ✓ 1. Fought successfully to ensure the health and safety of faculty, staff, students, and downtown residents in the wake of 9-11, and to relieve overcrowding at BMCC.
- ✓ 2. Fought successfully to win funds to repair BMCC infrastructure—including the elevators and escalators, and the outdated Heating and Air Conditioning System.
- ✓ 3. Worked with other city unions and downtown residents and business groups in an ongoing effort to insure the safe demolition and reconstruction of Fiterman Hall.
- ✓ 4. Increased the visibility and status of part-time faculty.
- ✓ 5. Fought successfully to (a) remove the bureaucratic administration application form that obstructed contractually mandated reassigned time for new faculty and (b) to expand the number of sabbaticals for senior faculty.
- ✓ 6. Supported faculty counselors in opposing the creation of the HEO counselor position in the latest PSC-CUNY Contract and petitioned the BMCC administration to increase the number of faculty counselors.
- ✓ 7. Worked with students and other citizens to protest budget cuts and tuition increases in the past four years, collecting 17,000 postcards from BMCC faculty, staff and students.
- ✓ 8. Won the right of faculty to participate in the Childcare Network of Manhattan, Bronx, Brooklyn, and Queens.
- ✓ 9. Expanded chapter membership by more than 50% in six years.
- ✓ 10. Built an active, democratic, and inclusive chapter whose activism was recognized by New York State United Teachers (NYSUT) when it awarded Jane Young the NYSUT member of the year award.
